Behaviour and Rewards

Dear Parents,

This leaflet is designed to share with you the standards of behaviour and attitude that is expected of your child at our school.

It is very important that we work together to maintain the high standards of behaviour we already have in school and that all children clearly understand what is expected of them.

We hope that by sharing our expectations and how children will be rewarded you can support us by encouraging your child at home.

Please keep this leaflet in a safe place and ask your child regularly how they are getting on!

Behaviour and rewards

Children will collect individual stars in order to achieve a bronze, silver and gold award over the school year.

Bronze award = 50 stars Silver award = 100 stars

Gold award = 200 stars

★ Children in Reception will collect 50 stars for each award.

☆ Platinum awards will also be available for exceptional behaviour and progress.

★ Stars will be given by adults for a range of behaviours that have been agreed and shared with the children in each year group.

Details for your child are shown on the next page.

There will be a series of reward assemblies throughout the year to recognise those children that achieve their rewards by the 'challenge date'.

Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated and all incidents will be recorded on the behaviour log and parents informed. Unacceptable behaviour includes:

- ❖ Violent behaviour
- ❖ Stealing
- ❖ Bullying
- ❖ Deliberately damaging/defacing equipment/property
- ❖ Disobedience – persistent refusal to follow instructions from an adult
- ❖ Racism
- ❖ Fighting

★ In addition a system of red and yellow cards will be used during playtime and lunchtime to deal with unacceptable behaviour. Children will be shown a yellow card as a warning that their behaviour is unacceptable. If the behaviour continues a red card will be given. All red card incidents will be recorded on the behaviour log and parents informed.



Good behaviour

In each Year 3 class there is a happy/sad face. A child writes their name under the sad or happy face. A child who appears on the happy face with two ticks next to their name will receive two extra stars.

In Year 3, when all the children in the class have achieved a set target for collecting stars before the deadline, they will be rewarded with golden time. The targets are as follows:

- 30 out of 50 bronze stars
- 50 out of 100 silver stars
- 70 out of 150 gold stars

Unacceptable behaviour

If a child's behaviour is unacceptable they are given a verbal warning.

If the behaviour continues they will have a 2nd warning and their name goes on the sad face.

When a name appears on the sad face, with two more ticks next to it, the child will be sent to another class (time out.) The teacher receiving a child from another class will ask for a reason why the child has been sent out. The child will receive a verbal reminder of correct behaviour etc. When the child returns to their classroom, the incident will be logged in the class behaviour book.
