

Intent for our PSHE curriculum

We intend that PSHE education will be the golden thread running through every aspect of school life.

At Bordesley Green Primary, we deliver a PSHE Curriculum that follows the three core areas of Health and Wellbeing, Relationships and Living in the Wider World provided by the PSHE Association Programme of Study. We ensure that the curriculum builds on prior learning as children move through the school, gradually expanding and deepening their knowledge, skills, and attributes.

We intend that, children will learn how to stay safe and healthy, build and maintain successful relationships and become active citizens, responsibly participating in society around them.

Furthermore, we aim that our curriculum prepares children to explore their attitudes, values and beliefs about issues and real-life situations that affect them. They learn to develop and use the skills, language and strategies taught to manage these situations should they encounter them, building a strong positive view of themselves, their identity and enhancing their confidence.

As well as this, we aim that the themes and topics support *the children's* social, moral, spiritual and cultural development and provide children with protective teaching on essential safeguarding issues, developing their knowledge of when and how they can ask for help.

We aim to further enhance the pupils SMSC development through cross-curricular links with Religious Education and Collective Worship, ensuring the children build strong and secure foundations to their learning.
